SWIMMING IN THE CONGO...

While elephants and tigers roam on land in Africa, Elephant fish and Tiger fish cruise underwater in the deep Congo River. The Goliath Tiger fish is said to grow up to 150lbs. and has terrifyingly long teeth. This fish is only located in the Congo River, which is the second largest river system in the world. Tiger fish have been reported to have killed humans who cross their watery paths. The Congo's Elephant fish uses its long



trunk-like snout to sift through river bottom sediments for food and is significantly less frightening in its appearance. Needless to say we will not be swimming in the Congo River!
