FAILED STATES INDEX...

Each year an organization called the Fund For Peace publishes a list of the world’s most vulnerable countries called the “Failed States Index.” This index draws on some 130,000 sources to analyze 177 countries and rates them on 12 factors ranging from refugees, poverty, public services,

development and human rights. Of the top 60 worst countries to live in 33 of them are located in Africa.
